- Acting as representative of site EHS for allocated investment projects within BioAtrium
- Coordinating EHS performance reportings for BioAtrium
- Supporting the BioAtrium emergency response organization

- Master of Science in Pharmaceutical Technology, Chemistry, Engineering, Biotechnology, Molecular Biology, Microbiology or equivalent
- Significant working experience in chemical or biological manufacturing, ideally in a leading role
- Swiss safety engineer (EKAS) or comparable EHS qualification
- In-depth knowledge of Swiss safety regulations
- Advanced experience in occupational or process safety in a scientific or technical environment
