Job Description Summary

- Configuration of lab PCs (policies, system settings, permissions), access rights and privileges in application software
- Administration of backup, archival, virtualization and execution of disaster recovery

Key requirements:

- Professional apprenticeship in computer science / IT, or completed bachelor in computer science / IT
- First experience working in a GxP environment; preferably in labs in the pharmaceutical industry
- Experience with Active Directory, administering permissions / privileges on Windows, application level, IT network and backup
- Experience working within a Quality System (i.e Risk Management, Validation, Change Control, CAPA etc) is a plus
- Administrator or system owner knowledge of lab software and other pharma software is an advantage
- Professional English and German skills (written, oral) are essential
