- Responsible for the execution of Supply Chain operational excellence projects in collaboration with Site Supply Chain Head
- Ensure efficient and effective Supply Chain business partnering between Commercial and Operations
- Coordination of supply & demand and ownership of Business Unit's Sales & Operations Plan.
